DUMPER DRIVING

This TBT must not be used as a substitute for the proper training of dumper drivers. It should serve only as a reminder to dumper drivers, and as general information for others.

- 1. You must not drive a dumper unless you are authorised to do so and are in the possession of a current certificate of training achievement.
- 2. For dumpers without a self-starter, ensure that when cranking the engine, the thumb is not in the way should the engine backfire (the correct method of cranking the engine should be demonstrated).
- 3. Do not leave keys in the ignition whilst the vehicle is unattended, take them with you.
- 4. Before operating check that tyres are fully inflated and the breaks are effective.
- 5. Obey site rules with regard to traffic routes, speed limits, etc. Give pedestrians plenty of room.
- 6. Do not carry passengers.
- 7. While the skip is being loaded, apply the handbrake and stand well clear do not remain on the dumper.
- 8. Loads must be secure, and within the capacity of the machine.
- 9. Do not carry loads which overhang excessively, or those which you have to hang on to.

- 10. Do not allow the load to obscure your forward vision.
- 11. Make sure the skip safety catch is engaged before moving off.
- 12. Beware of the back end swinging out with rear wheel steering.
- 13. Avoid harsh acceleration and breaking. Do not allow the wheels to spin.
- 14. On steep gradients, travel with the load up the slope.
- 15. On down gradients, do not rely solely on the brakes always use a low gear.
- 16. Do not travel across steep gradients.
- 17. Before tipping, make sure that no person or obstruction is in the way.
- 18. Do not tip into an excavation unless effective stop blocks have been provided. Ensure the blocks are secure and always use them.
- 19. Do not take the dumper onto a public road unless you and the vehicle are licensed and equipped for the purpose, and you have been authorised to do so.
- 20.At the end of working hours, the machine should be effectively immobilised seek advice or instruction if necessary.
- 21. Do not 'bump start' other vehicles.
- 22. Do not tow a lighting tower with mast raised always lower it first.

- 23. Do not use lifting gear for towing.
- 24.If a seat belt is fitted, wear it correctly.
- 25.Do not leave the dumper unattended with the engine running.
- 26.Do not attempt to drive a dumper which is in any way defective report it at once.
