



DUMPER KEYS

This TBT must not be used as a substitute for the proper training of dumper drivers. It should serve only as a reminder to dumper drivers, and as general information for others.

Many accidents are the result of untrained or inexperienced workers driving construction vehicles. The use of any site plant or vehicle should be restricted to competent drivers who have been authorised to operate that vehicle.

Help prevent any unauthorised use by:

- only allowing authorised drivers to hold vehicle keys. Drivers should not loan keys to other workers
- instructing drivers to turn off a vehicle's engine and remove the key whenever they leave that vehicle (in the case of non-key-coded plant i.e. dumpers).

Ensure that when leaving the dumper, the parking brake is applied, the engine is switched off and the key has been removed.

All non-key-coded plant should be parked in a safe place and position when not in use and keys should be stored in a safe place which is accessible by authorised persons only.
